Patient exhibited radiographic signs of scurvy on X-ray of the left knee and on a CT of the left hip, and showed similar findings in other long bones on a skeletal survey: Demineralization of the cortex of metaphyses results in a characteristic radiographic “ground glass” appearance, alternating radiolucent (Trümmerfeld zone) and radiopaque (White line of Frankel) bands, which represent defective bone matrix formation and poor resorption respectively. Wimberger Ring Sign was more subtle in our cases.
